



BSV **COVID Safety** Protocols for In-person Volunteers

Spring 2021

- **In-person Support:** Existing BSV Volunteers (formerly from “Distance Learning”) may support in-person at preschool and elementary sites only, but only at the request of their Host Teacher, (or at middle/high schools at the request of their Host Teacher, and with Principal approval)
- **One Stable Group:** Volunteers may only support in-person in one stable group (which means selecting 1 classroom to support, if volunteers have more than 1 assignment)
- **Vaccination:** BSV highly recommends but does not require that in-person volunteers be fully vaccinated
- **Mandatory Health Screener:** Volunteers (like all students and teachers) must complete the BUSD health screener app below every day they go to campus to ensure they are healthy BEFORE arriving
 - Health screener URL: <http://bit.ly/berkeleyhealthscreener>
 - Note: where it asks for student name, enter volunteer name
- **Room Capacity:** Volunteer presence should never exceed the specified room capacity (discuss with Host Teacher)
- **Masks:** Volunteers should wear acceptable masks at all times (no gaiters, bandanas, or valves)
- **Distancing:** Volunteers must maintain social distancing of at least 4 feet at all times
- **Sanitizing:** Sanitize your hands frequently throughout the day
- **Site Specifics:** Host Teachers will orient volunteers to additional site-specific safety protocols, as needed
- **Name Badges:** BSV will not be distributing BSV Name Badges this spring. Instead, please check in at the front office when you arrive to get a visitor sticker/temporary name badge.
