- **Project Title**
- **Brief Project Summary** (100 words max)
- **Priority Areas:** Select 1-2 Priority Areas
 - Emotional Health & Wellness
 - Digital Equity
 - Equitable Family Engagement
 - Positive Racial Identity Development
 - Inclusive & Culturally Relevant Learning
- **Equity Design:**
 - *For whom?* Who is the intended audience for this project? Please include a racial/ethnic breakdown, if possible. (Thoughtful approximations are OK.) Please also address how will you invite and ensure full participation of the intended audience. (300 words max)
 - *By whom?* Who designed your project? Who will be leading it/interfacing with students? How are these educators uniquely qualified to lead this project? (To what extent do they represent or reflect the students they are serving?) (300 words max)
 - *What?* Describe the chosen curriculum or content for your project. Describe its cultural relevance to your intended audience. If it involves a field trip, describe how the field trip is integrated into a larger unit or course of study. If you are using a pre-existing program/curriculum, please address what is already known about how effective the program/curriculum is known to be with your intended audience. (300 words max)
 - *How?* Describe how you plan to execute your project (i.e. delivery methods or pedagogy*), and why you believe these methods will resonate with your chosen audience. If relevant, describe how you'll ensure your project is linguistically accessible to your audience. (300 words max)
- **Committed Cohort**
 - Using a simple phrase, describe the general cohort of educators that your proposal represents. For example: 3rd grade team at Malcolm X, OFEE specialists @ BUSD, or Spanish teachers @ Berkeley High.
 - Of the total number of educators in your overall cohort, how many are fully committed to THIS project? (I.e. # of committed/ # total)
 - Name every committed educator in your cohort, as we may be following up with them. Use the blue "Add another response" for every subsequent cohort member.
 - Describe what systems and structures (i.e. standing meetings, agendas, shared docs, assessments, etc.) your cohort has or will put in place to communicate, collaborate & coordinate efforts across the cohort, throughout the project. (200 words max)
- **Project Goals, Timeline & Budget**
 - List 1-3 project goals, and how you plan to assess each one. (300 words max)
 - Please include a month-by-month timeline (bullets are fine) of major implementation and evaluation activities below. (400 words max)
 - Attach your budget (see example budget for reference)
